If major disputes arise and cannot be resolved by the principal investigator (or it involves the principal investigator with the collaborators), the dispute is arbitrated by a third party; in this case, it is the head of the LHRC or even the executive director of the Health Sciences Research Center (HSRC). The decision of the head of the LHRC or the executive director of the HSRC is final.
9. You agree on the confidentiality of the research findings until they are published or presented in a conference by a member of the research team.
10. The LHRC reserves the right to terminate the research collaboration should the collaborator places the LHRC reputation into disrepute, or fail to comply with the agreed terms of the project.
